SUBMISSION FORMAT

Please send an email with the subject heading "SEM Day of Ethno Submission" and attach a PDF or Word document including the following information:

- 1. Your name, academic affiliation (or independent status), position, and email address. If you are a student, please list your current degree program.
- 2. Title of presentation, including musical culture that will be presented.
- 3. A one-paragraph abstract of the workshop *and* an outline of what you will cover in your workshop, including participatory music-making activities.

All submissions must be received by midnight EDT, June 1, 2021. Notification of acceptance will be sent electronically by June 15, 2021.
